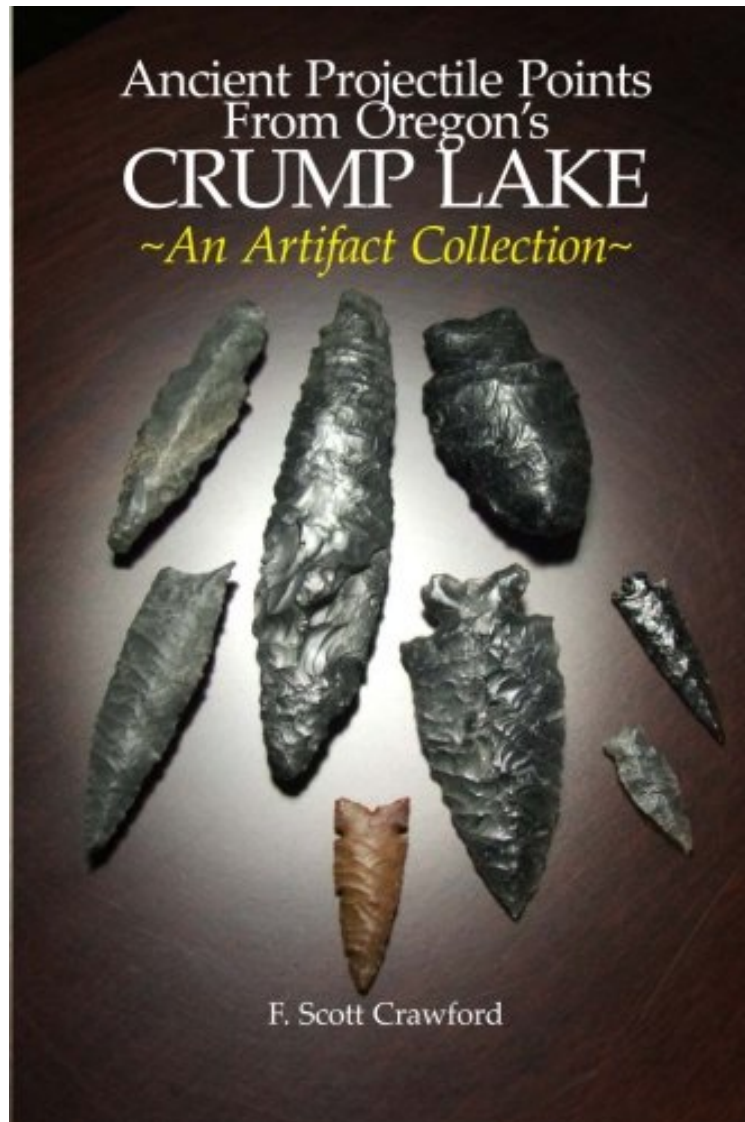

I was very disappointed in the content and presentation of points. In some instances, the same points were pictured up to six times!!! Also, the pictures were not professional at

all, and the points shown do not even come close to representing the variety and types of materials that have been found in the area. I feel certain this book was prepared in very short order and involved very little research and time. Based on the extensive collections available from the Crump Lake area and the great body of literature available on the Great Basin, including the scholarly treatises on the ancient cultures of the Western United States, I had anticipated that an expensive book of this nature would be much more thorough, both in terms of the types of points and blades used by the Paleo and Desert Archaic cultures that inhabited the region and, at the very least, a somewhat detailed description of how they lived and what their cultures were like.
