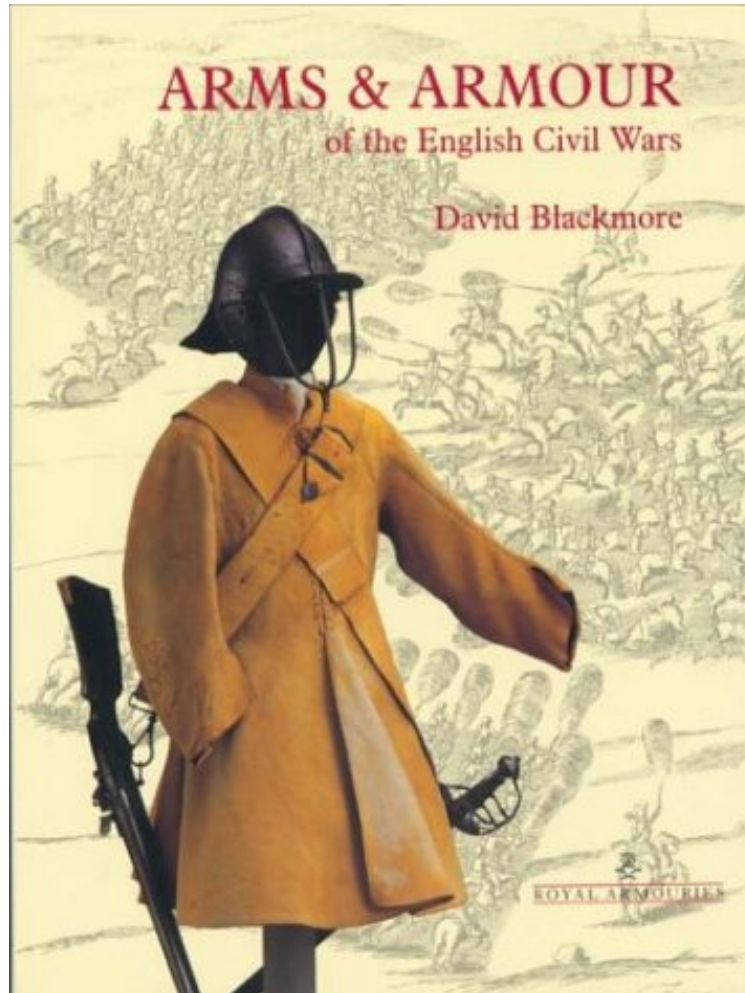

The text is supported by a wide variety of photographs, many black and white and 8 color, buff coats patterns, firearms lock types, leather guns, cuirassier armour, arquebus armour, swords, cavalry firearms, pikeman's armour, for the Scottish weapon fans I have to say that they were omitted. This is the first book I bought from the Royal Armouries, fascinating to anyone interested in weapons and equipment of the 17th century Arms and Armour of the ECW armies. The book is only 99 pages but very concise, a very worthwhile volume to add to your library, an absolute must for all English Civil War enthusiasts, armour fans or weapons of the period.

This book uses the magnificent collections of arms and armour from the Royal Armouries, augmented by the unique Civil War Armoury at Littlecote House, and others, to show the weapons and armours used by the Englishmen who fought for King or Parliament during the Civil War.
