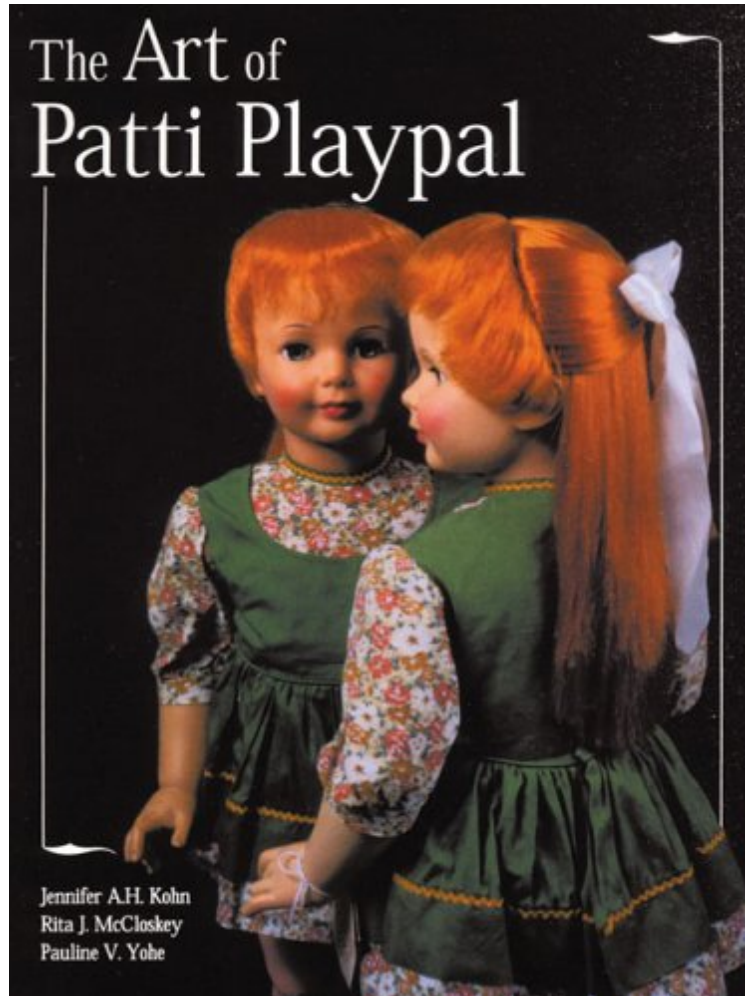

The book begins with an introduction on the three authors of this wonderful book. Then moves on to inform regarding the artist, Neil Estern, who designed the first

Pattis for Ideal. His wife, Anne, designed many of Patti's early fashions. The book details Patti's anatomy and markings, hairstyles, makeup coloring, clothing (outfits designed by Anne Estern, Mary Bauer and Judith Albert), then moves through a section on other companion dolls in the Playpal family- Peter Playpal, Shirley Temple, Penny, Suzy, Bonnie and Johnny, cousins Saucy Walker and Bye Bye Baby- all by Ideal. There is also a chapter devoted to care and the maintenance of the Playpal dolls, which I found to be informative and just what I needed to bring my Patti back to her original luster. The last chapter devotes several pages to knock-off versions of Patti. I looked at other books on

Patti Playpal and found this one to have the most detailed information as to what met my criteria. Fabulous color photographs on each of the 174 pages of the book.
