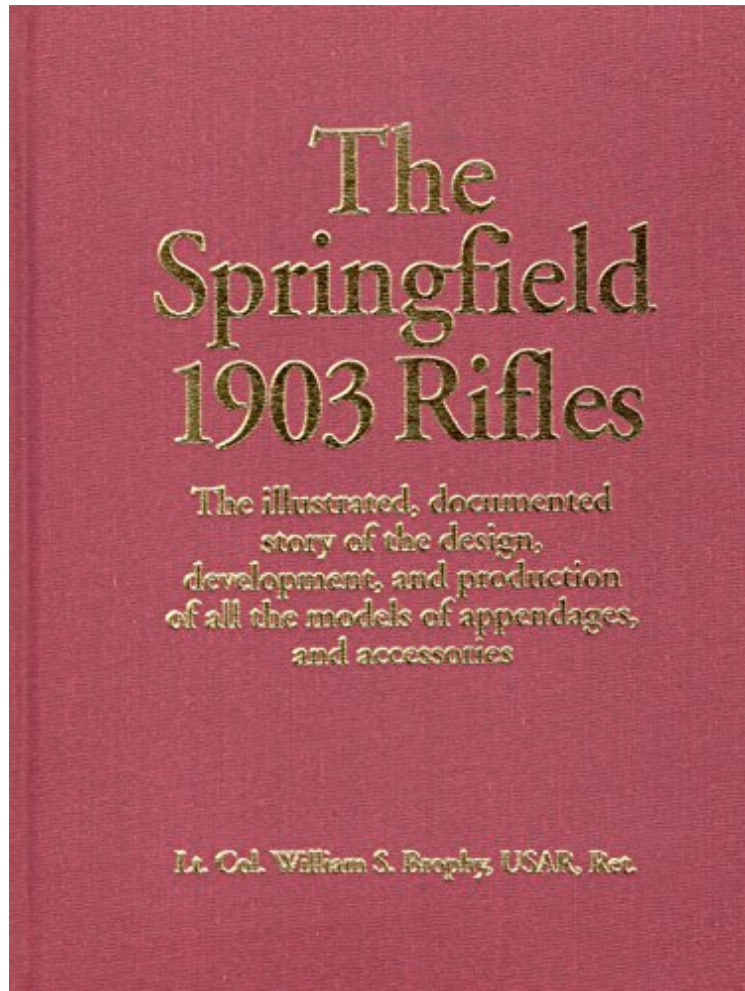

It is an excellent book for anyone collecting 1903 Springfield rifles, and covers almost every aspect of the design, manufacture, and distribution

of the 1903 Springfield. It is not, however all inclusive, and several areas were covered in much more detail than others. The .22 rifle was detailed to the point of being almost half the total volume of the book, while other areas, such as those rifles manufactured by Rock Island were sparse in detail, and information. I realize the title should forewarn that it covers the Springfield rifle, which it does, but there was plenty of information about the Remington 1903 A-1, 03-A3, and 03-A4, and they are not Springfield rifles either. I had to purchase a separate book about the 1903 Rock Island in order to learn about that specific rifle. I felt a lot of this information could have, and should have been included in this book as well. It's still a valuable, and informative book on the subject, but given it's a somewhat expensive book, it would have been better if it was more comprehensive.

HughesThis book covers the Springfield 1903 rifle variations from the original experimental rifles of 1900 (a replacement for the Krag) through the WW2 models (A3 A4, plus the Remington M1903, and various other versions). That takes up the first 300+ pages. The remainder of the book includes detailed information on related "peripherals" such as bayonets, cartridge belts, grenade launchers, M1918 periscopes, slings, sights, etc. Of significance are the charts of Serial Production Numbers and Ordnance Inspectors' Marks. The book is filled with innumerable photos, drawings, and original schematics. For the owner and collector of the US Springfield '03, this is THE definitive resource.
